Role of the Coach

As a Varsity Vipers coach your role is to develop junior basketball players in a fun, positive and supportive environment.

Be What You Want To See

As a coach you must always demonstrate acceptable behaviour and language

Focus on Development Not Winning

We all want to win but our focus should be on development. That means giving equal court time as much as possible

Be Organised

Attend all training sessions and games and organise a replacement if you can't be there

Be Positive or it's Pointless

We want basketball to be fun so be positive at all times



Role of the Manager

As a Varsity Vipers manager your role is to support the coach by organising and communicating with the players and parents.

Communication

Establish a consistent method of communicating with players / parents such as group text, messenger group or Facebook page

Training sessions

Communicate with the team each week to confirm training and game time and remind players to arrive 15 minutes before scheduled game time

Scoring roster

Organise a scoring bench roster with the parents so that we always have a scorer from our club

Uniforms

Make sure that all players are in uniform - we play in purple except where playing another Varsity team in which case the second listed team wears the alternate stripe

Coaches and Managers:

Always be respectful, courteous and in control

Coaches and managers must always be respectful, courteous and in control in your interactions with opponents, coaches, officials, administrators, parents, spectators and the media. Encourage your players to do the same.

Be professional

Be professional in all actions and accept responsibility for your behaviour and that of your players.

Get qualified

Obtain coaching qualifications and keep up to date with the latest practices and principles of growth and development of young people.

Respect your players

Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person



Be appropriate

Any physical contact with a young person must be appropriate to the situation and necessary for the player's skill development.

De-escalate conflicts

If a conflict arises during training or a game you should always work to de-escalate the conflict, moving your players away from opponents and obeying the instructions of officials.

GCBA has a zero tolerance policy towards the abuse of players and officials.

Obtain and maintain your Blue Card

A Working with Children Check (blue card) or exemption is required for all coaches and managers. The club maintains a register for all coaches and managers.
